Student Complaint Procedure

While our “open door policy” is in place to handle any small issues, we wanted to provide you with the procedure to bring forward a complaint.

Complaint Procedures are noted below:

Student complaints must be submitted in writing, providing as much detail as possible to:

- We will contact the student to schedule a meeting to discuss the complaint and possible resolution within 48 hours of receipt of the written complaint. The student is allowed to have another person present at this meeting and/or have another person make oral submissions on their behalf.
- Minutes will be taken during this meeting and a copy will be provided to the student with a copy kept in the students' file at the campus for a minimum of 3 years.
- The student will receive a decision, including justification in writing within 5 days from the date of the meeting.

Should the student feel that a further review of the decision is needed they can request a review hearing by mailing a written request to the attention of:

- We will contact the student to schedule a meeting and review the decision of the complaint within 72 hours of receipt of the written review request. The student is allowed to have another person present at this meeting and/or have another person make oral submissions on their behalf.
- Minutes will be taken during this meeting and a copy will be provided to the student with a copy kept in the students; file at the campus for a minimum of 3 years.
- The student will receive a decision, including justification in writing within 5 days from the date of the meeting

If the student is not satisfied with the outcome from the above process, they are encouraged to refer the complaint to the Superintendent of Ontario Career Colleges located at the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities 77 Wellesley Street West, Box 977, Toronto, ON M7A 1N3
